# Carthage Final Qualifier Friday, March 1, 2019 LAST UPDATE: February 27, 2019

**Eligibility:** Open to members of intercollegiate teams and approved unattached athletes.

High school athletes are NOT eligible.

Entry Must be received by 12:00 noon on Wednesday, February 27<sup>th</sup>.

**Deadline:** All entries will be done online via Direct Athletics (www.directathletics.com).

**Entry Limit:** None. You may run more than one relay team.

**Entry Fee:** \$250.00 Per Team (\$500.00 Men & Women combined)

Individual Entries - \$30.00 - Are permitted. Unattached Relays - \$100.00 - Are permitted. Please make all checks payable to Carthage College

**Scratches:** Scratches only on day of meet. No additions!

**Info Packets:** Pick up packet and pay fees upon arrival at finish clerk's table near finish line.

**Track:** 6-Lane 200-meter Mondo surface. HJ / LJ/ TJ/ PV surface is same as track. Chalk only for field

event marks- chalk will be provided at event site.

NO FOOD OR DRINK ON THE TRACK LEVEL.

**Spikes:** 1/4' are maximum allowed. Pyramid only. Shoes will be checked! Carthage WILL NOT provide

replacement spikes.

**Timing:** Finish Lynx and NCAA rules will govern the meet.

**Weigh-In:** Throwing implements must be weighed in at venue between 1:45 and 2:45 p.m.

Any and all illegal implements will be impounded until completion of the event(s).

**Results:** Live results will be posted online by Sportstats (www.sportstats.us). In addition, results will be

posted on a results board after each completed event. Results will also be posted online at the conclusion of the event on Carthage Athletics, TFRRS, and Sportstats by meet management.

**NCAA Qualifiers:** Results will be posted to TFRRS by meet management following the meet.

**Dressing Rooms:** Available on lower level of TARC. Please provide your own towels and locks.

**Trainers:** Certified athletic training staff will be available throughout the meet.

## **Indoor Final Qualifying Meet Advancement Procedures**

#### 55 Meters and 55 Hurdles:

8 fastest collegiate times will advance to the final round by time only.

## Other races/relays (200m and up):

Run as timed finals in sections

#### Seeding

All heats will be ordered fast to slow. Jumps/Throws flights will be worst to best. 55m & 55H prelims will be random seeding.

200m, 400m, 1600m Relay: 5,6,4,3,2,1

55m/55h Finals:

Heat of 8: 4,5,3,6,2,7,1,8 -OR- 2 Heats of 4: 5,6,4,7...Fastest finals heat will run first.

800m and up: Hip numbers at random within each heat

## Long Jump, Triple Jump, Shot Put, Weight Throw:

Preliminary rounds will be contested in flights - 3 attempts will be allowed; top 9 collegiate marks will advance to the final round for 3 additional attempts

### **Non-collegiate Athletes:**

Unattached athletes do not advance to final round of field events and running events with a preliminary round.

## **SPIKES**

The only spike pin allowed for our Track facility is the 1/4" pyramid spike.

# ATHLETES WILL NOT RUN IF THEY DO NOT COMPLY WITH THIS RULE.

Spike checks will be checked before the first running event in the Clerk's area. Spikes must be checked prior to the start of your race. Anyone found using any spikes other than ¼" Pyramid Spikes will be disqualified.
