Carthage College was founded in 1847 by Lutheran pioneers in education in the small town of Hillsboro, Illinois as The Literary and Theological Institute of the Lutheran Church in the Far West. The name was soon shortened to Hillsboro College. With a two-person faculty and 79 students, Hillsboro promised "a course of study designed to be thorough and practical, and to embrace all the branches of learning, usually pursued in the best academies and colleges."

In 1852, the college moved to Springfield, Illinois and assumed the name of Illinois State University. During this period, Abraham Lincoln served briefly on the Board of Trustees from 1860 to 1861, while his son Robert Todd Lincoln was a student in Illinois State University's preparatory department from 1853 to 1859. Illinois State University's enrollment dwindled during the Civil War, and in 1870 the college moved again, this time to the rural, west-central city of Carthage, Illinois, where the college acquired its current name.

The Great Depression and World War II lowered enrollment to 131 students in 1943, but enrollment increased again after the war as a result of the G.I. Bill.

After years of financial challenges, shifts in Lutheran synodical support, and searches for a suitable location, Carthage's Board of Trustees voted unanimously in 1957 to open a campus in Kenosha, Wisconsin. The lake-shore campus was dedicated on Oct. 14, 1962.

Dave Roehl begins his 15th year as Carthage's head men's golf coach in 2016-17 (1330-280-19, 14 years). A native of Menasha, Wis., Roehl attended the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh, where he graduated in 1977 with a bachelor's in physical education and health.

He served as the boy's basketball and baseball coach at Somers Shoreland Lutheran High School from 1979-98. Roehl, a long-time private golf instructor at Brighton Dale Golf Links in Kansasville, Wis., also served as Carthage's men's basketball assistant coach for 10 years between 2004 and 2013 after serving as a part-time assistant coach for four seasons between 2000 and 2003.

Roehl has served a pair of three-year terms on the NCAA Division III Men's Golf Championship Committee, the first from 2006 to 2008 and the other from 2012 to 2014.

2016 SEASON PREVIEW



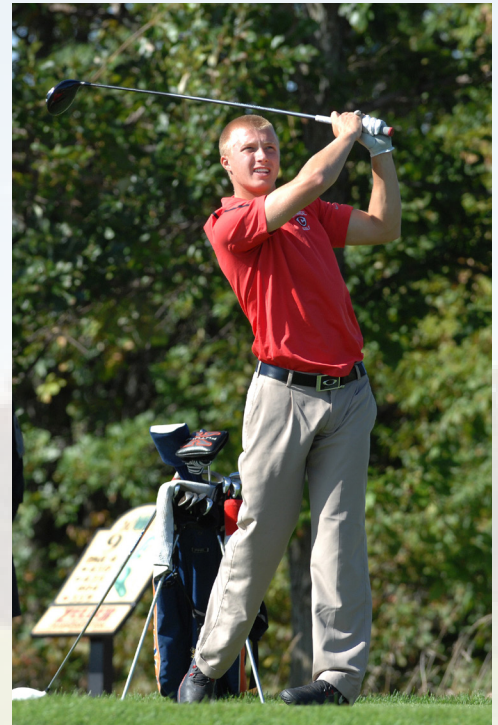
The Carthage College men's golf team registered first place on five occasions in 2015-16. The 2015-16 season also included a second-place finish at the CCIW Men's Golf Championship. The 2016-17 Red Men roster sports 13 golfers, all of whom saw action on the varsity level in 2015-16.

Gone from last year's squad is Jarrett Simonson, who ended his senior campaign with a four-day score of 298 (+10) at the 2015-16 CCIW Men's Golf Championship. Simonson will enter his first season as a graduate assistant for the Red Men golf team.

Returning for Carthage is the dynamic duo of Matt Meneghetti and Alex Stewart.

Meneghetti paced the Red Men with an average score of 73.6 in 12 events last season. The Schererville, Ind. native tallied second place at the 2015-16 CCIW Men's Golf Championship, four strokes off the lead.

Stewart notched an average score of 75 in 12 events last season. This includes a four-day score of 295 (+7) at the 2015-16 CCIW Men's Golf Championship, good enough for seventh place.

The 2016-17 Red Men "B" roster includes nine freshman trying to crack the lineup.

"Our older players take the freshman under their wing," said Carthage head men's golf coach Dave Roehl. "Our team as a whole integrates very well."

The College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin looks to be a challenge once again. The combination of experience and last season's results give the Red Men every reason to believe they can win it.

"The nice thing about the CCIW is that more teams are putting more of an emphasis on the competitiveness of golf," said Roehl. "We have quite a few teams within the structure of the conference that will play at a high level."

The Red Men will open the 2016-17 season at the Aurora University Invite on Tuesday, September 6. Tee-time from the Blackberry Oaks Golf Course in Aurora, Ill. is scheduled for 8:00 a.m.

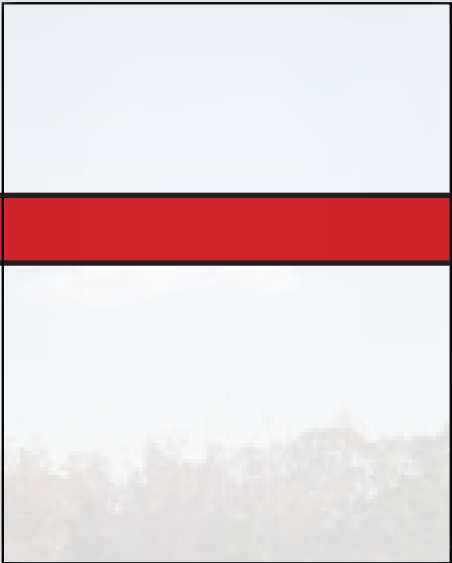

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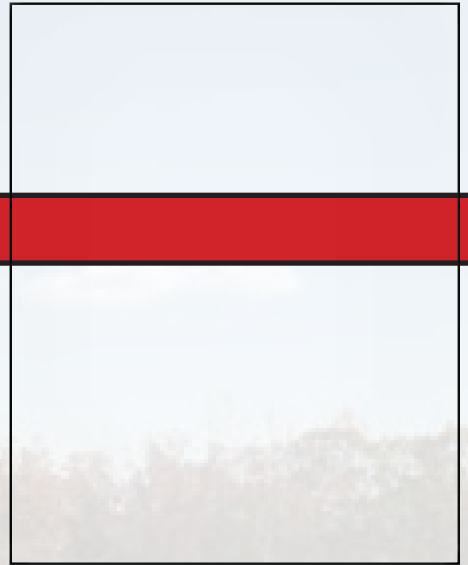

Jon Swift, who died in 2012, completed his 14th and final season as men's golf coach in 1996 and retired with 35 years of service to Carthage. Since the College reinstated golf in 1983, Swift brought the program to national prominence, winning four consecutive CCIW titles from 1991 to 1994 and another in 1996 and making five straight appearances in the NCAA Men's Golf Championship from 1992 to 1996. Swift, whose men's golf record stands at 616-194-6 over 14 years, was inducted into the Carthage Athletic Hall of Fame in 1993.
